

After a one-year postponement, Russian River Valley Winegrowers hosted our signature Russian River Valley Paulée dinner to kick off Labor Day Weekend on Friday, September 3rd, 2021 at Bricoleur Vineyards in Windsor, Ca.

The Annual Paulée featured 25 of our member wineries pouring world class Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Syrah, Zinfandel and Sauvignon Blanc. The Paulée offers guests an unmatched tasting experience in both wine and food. In the spirit of the Paulée tradition, which originated in Burgundy, the Russian River Valley Paulée brings winemakers and collectors together to enjoy an elegant multi-course meal paired with wines from winemakers and guests' personal cellars, including special, limited, and rare vintages. The event hosted over 175 consumers to the area, along with a dozen Bay Area media attendees.

Our culinary partners for 2021 were Chef Evan Castro of Bricoleur Vineyards, under the advisement and consult of Chef Charlie Palmer and Chef Nate Appleman. Chef Mark Stark of Stark Reality Restaurants joined the team to create an amazing meal for guests to enjoy.

### Financial Report

#### Michelle Muth Ausburn Treasurer



#### **FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS OF 2021**

While 2021 proved to be another challenging year, we continue to be excited about the future of RRVW and the overall financial health of the organization.

#### **REVENUES**

Total revenues were \$173,962, exceeding budgeted revenues of \$148,250 by \$25,712. The main drivers of revenue were membership dues and Paulée event revenue. Membership dues totaled \$136,400, short of budget goal of \$147,500 by \$11,100. Paulée generated \$32,266 in revenue and was not included in the budget.

#### **EXPENSES**

Actual expenses were \$234,171, exceeding budgeted expenses of \$226,960 by \$7,211. The variance is primarily related to employee turnover and Paulée event expenses, both of which were not included in the budget.

#### **NET INCOME**

Actual net loss totaled \$60,209, a favorable variance of \$18,501 compared to budget net loss of \$78,710.

#### **RESERVES**

As of the close of 2021, RRVW held \$153,722 in reserves in a money market account.

## "THE NEIGHBORHOODS SERIES" BY SOMMVIVANT, AMANDA MCCROSSIN



With heavy restrictions on indoor gatherings in the first half of 2021, Russian River Valley Winegrowers continued promotions of the Neighborhoods initiative virtually with a tasting series with sommelier, Amanda McCrossin. Amanda's YouTube Channel, Sommvivant, boasts over 26,000 fans. The six live sessions were approximately 30 minutes in length and occurred weekly starting on. The series combined both grape-growing and winemaking by featuring one grower and winery for each neighborhood.



### RAID Y(OUR) CELLAR WITH BENCHMARK WINE GROUP


Benchmark Wine Group pivoted in 2020 to host a virtual winetasting series called "Raid Y (our) Cellars," featuring wines and winemakers from across the globe. Benchmark Wine Group is the leading source of fine and rare wine for wine retailers, restaurants, and collectors around the world. They agreed to feature all six of the Russian River Valley Neighborhoods in a two-part series in August. Led by Master Sommelier Jodi Bronchtein, the two-part series collectively spanned over two hours and was promoted to BWG's extensive consumer list. Participating wineries included Ancient Oak Cellars, Kanzler Family Vineyards, Foppiano Vineyards, Benovia Winery, Pellegrini Olivet Lane, and Gary Farrell Vineyards.



### Neighborhoods Report

### WHAT RRVW HOPES TO ACCOMPLISH IN 2022

Russian River Valley Winegrowers is kicking off 2022 with updated print and digital assets to better represent the Neighborhoods to both trade and consumer audiences. These assets will come together with existing materials to create a new digital toolkit for members to use. The materials will be presented at RRVW's first quarterly educational series in April at Rodney Strong Vineyards, where winery and growers can learn more about the Neighborhoods and how to present the information to new audiences.





### Member Programs \_

Despite an eventful and difficult harvest due to the Wallbridge and Glass Fires in 2020, Russian River Valley Winegrowers was pleased to retain a strong contingent of grower and winery members across the AVA. By the end of 2021, RRVW's membership base had over 150 winery and grower members collectively. Revenues were down for membership dues because of lower yields during the 2020 harvest, however, DTC wine sales soared to record highs in 2020 and 2021, likely a result of stay-at-home orders throughout the nation. We continued to hold our DTC Networking Group meetings and hosted a couple of them in-person at member wineries including Pellegrini Olivet Lane and Martinelli Winery. Several guests speakers and topics included Amanda McCrossin, Sommvivant, on creating in-house video content, John at Community Benchmark on the importance of sales analytics to DTC growth, and social media strategist Shana Bull on current social media trends.



We were pleased to host our first in-person membership event since early 2020 in May at Medlock Ames, resuming our 'Vineyard Walks' series. The event was hosted by Board Member and Secretary, Kim Pasquali, along with assistant winemaker Abby Watt. While Medlock Ames Bell Mountain Ranch property is mainly situated in Alexander Valley and on the border of Chalk Hill, we loved learning about Medlock Ames unique two-acre parcel dedicated to Chardonnay is technically classified as part of Russian River Valley!

Our second Vineyard Walk was hosted at Paradise Ridge in Santa Rosa in August by principal and owner Renee Byck and events director, Colleen Patten. It was wonderful to gather at this unique and special property after their rebuild from the Tubbs Fire in 2017. The property is truly an outdoor art museum, showcasing several sculptures from Burning Man as well as boasting a beautiful amphitheater with spectacular views over Santa Rosa.

Our **Annual Member BBQ** in October, timed appropriately as an "end of harvest" celebration, saw our largest turnout of members with over 80 people in attendance. Members enjoyed traditional California tri-tip and other delectable sides prepared by master grillers and Board members, Clark Lystra and Chris Crispo. RRVW collected 387 pounds of non-perishable food items for the Redwood Empire Food Bank. A special thank you to Gio Balistreri and his team at Russian River Vineyards for hosting the 2021 BBQ.

We concluded the year with our **Annual Holiday Party** at Benovia Winery. Members enjoyed bites from Journeyman Meat Co. and wines from across Russian River Valley on December 8. A special thank you to Mike Sullivan, Joe Anderson, and the team at Benovia for hosting us!
